

**New Hampshire Sheep & Wool Festival
Hopkinton Fairgrounds
Contoocook, NH
Commercial Booth Rental Agreement**

Thank you very much for your interest in the NH Sheep & Wool Festival.

All non-food booths must be sheep, wool, or natural fiber related, unless previously accepted (jewelry, baskets, etc.).

As we continue to reach our limit for vendors earlier in the year, the festival vendor committee reserves the right to reject a booth applicant for lack of suitability or compatibility. Pre-registration does NOT guarantee a space; we will accept vendors on a “festival need” basis. Returning vendors that meet our requirements and are in keeping with the purpose of the festival will be given first choice, if the forms are returned by January 1. If you are not accepted, we will return your check.

All NEW vendors are asked to include photos that represent the items they will be selling. It is highly recommended that all vendors be as specific as possible about their wares. We will review the applications of returning vendors by January 15th and assign remaining spaces to new vendors at that time.

Until the festival brings in more customers, we will not be increasing the amount of vendors that we currently allow.

We reserve the right to reject any vendor who does not treat everyone with courtesy.

The festival vendor committee, whose decision will be final, shall decide disputes arising from any cause.

All vendors understand that they are responsible for any commitments they make at the festival.

It is required that each vendor have proof of his or her own liability insurance, and that a binder from the insurance company be included with the application.

Vendors may not share space with another vendor, unless the other vendor is listed on the application.

Please NOTE that booths are required to remain open from 9 am to 5 pm Saturday and from 9 am to 4 pm on Sunday. Set up is Friday from 7 am to 8 pm. and Saturday morning prior to 8:45 am. Any vendor who tears down or leaves before the festival ends will not be allowed back the following year.

All booth material must stay within the boundaries of the designated Booth space.

All vendors are responsible for keeping their space clean at all times, and for cleaning their area at the end of the festival. Vendors space will be left as clean as they found it or they will not be invited back.

Signs and displays shall not be so large as to interfere with the view of the neighboring booths.

No animals except those that are registered with the festival committee, have proper papers, and in pens are permitted at the festival (NO DOGS with the exception of service dogs).

There will be no animals in vendor barns, with the exception of those in cages.

There will be no moving vehicles during open festival hours. All vehicles will be parked in their designated parking area 15 minutes prior to opening, and will not move until the festival closes at night. All vendors will receive 2 passes per booth space, which allows you to enter the fairgrounds for free. If you do not bring your pass with you either of the 2 days, you will be required to purchase a ticket to enter the fairgrounds.
